MISSION STATEMENT: Golden Retriever Rescue of Fairbanks is a nonprofit organization of dedicated volunteers who work at placing unwanted, neglected or relinquished dogs in a loving forever home and family. We also answer questions, and provide information and education about these very special animals. Our dogs come from the Animal Shelter and or from families that must relinquish them due to personal hardship, special needs, or medical reasons. We accept Golden Retrievers and other mixed breeds for placement and foster the dogs in our volunteer homes until the right family is found. All of our dogs have a full physical exam done by Aurora Animal Clinic and are spayed or neutered, vaccinated, x-rayed, and wormed prior to adoption. Dogs older than 5 years also have additional tests such as blood work to make sure they are healthy prior to placement. Adoption fees are kept as low as possible and aid in the recovery of the cost of the vet bills so that we may continue this work.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: In order to make this event safe and enjoyable for everyone, Golden Retriever Rescue of Fairbanks has established specific rules for participation in this event. These rules are set out in the attached release. By signing this release each participant, or their legal guardian, agrees to abide by the rules and releases GRRF from any and all liability stemming from participation in the above described event. Each participant or their legal guardian must have signed a copy of this release on file before participating in the parade. If we do not have a signed release, we will ask you to leave this event. We deeply regret any inconvenience this may cause you.

PARADE START: Once again the staging area will be at the Carlson Center. All participants must be in line by 9:30 am. The parade will begin sharply at 10 am.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In order to make this event safe and enjoyable for everyone Golden Retriever Rescue of Fairbanks (hereinafter “GRRF”) has established the following rules for participation. By signing this document each participant, or their legal guardian, agrees to abide by the following rules and releases GRRF from any and all liability stemming from participation in the above described event.

1. GRRF accepts no responsibility for the care and/or supervision of minor children under the age of eighteen years (hereinafter “minors”). Minors must be supervised at all times by a designated adult over the age of eighteen years (hereinafter “designated adult”).
2. GRRF’s entry in the parade will consist of a trailer float pulled by a towing vehicle. The purpose of the float is to provide resting area for the older or infirm dogs participating in the parade. Minors and other participants will be allowed to ride the float on a space available basis only. Minors and other participants riding on the float must remain under the immediate supervision of their designated adult. Participants will be allowed to enter and exit the float only when the float has come to a complete stop. Under no circumstances will anyone attempt to enter or exit the towing vehicle or the float at any time. Refreshments, water and waste bags and receptacles may also be stored on the float. These items may be retrieved from the float only when the float has come to a complete stop and the driver has signaled that it is safe to retrieve these items. Under no circumstances will any participant attempt to approach the float or retrieve anything from the float at any other time.
3. Participants will be solely responsible for the supervision and behavior of their dogs at all times. Participants understand that, during the course of this event, their dog may be exposed to small minor children, loud or unexpected noises, other animals, and other foreseen or unforeseen events. All participants agree to withdraw their dogs immediately from the parade if their animal exhibits aggression towards any other participant or spectator.
4. Any participants found to be in violation of these rules will be asked to leave the parade immediately. The designed adult will be responsible for separately transporting any minor / minors to the conclusion of the parade route. Participants will be responsible for transporting their dogs to the conclusion of the parade route.
5. I have read the above document and understand its contents. I understand that there are inherent dangers in engaging in the above described parade activities including but not limited to dog bite, being struck or run over by motorized vehicles or trailers, falling, serious injury or death. I hereby waive and release any and all rights and claims against the persons or organizations affiliated with GRRF, including parade organizers, sponsors, float drivers, and/or property owners. I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the above individuals. This release is intended to constitute a release and waiver of any and all claims asserted by me, my heirs, executors or assigns, of consequences or harm to me, my property, or my children or wards arising out of the know or unknown risks, conditions, and/or hazards or participating in the above described activity.
